The Trustees have utilized the contributions made to the trust by its settler and donors towards rendering help for educational and medical purposes to needy people and also in giving donations to various institutions engaged in similar charitable and philanthropic activities.

Since 2013, the foundation has started working on creating awareness on Organ Donation under ORGAN (Organ Receiving & Giving Awareness Network) India.

ORGAN India aims to put together all key elements required to fully execute an operational organ donor system in India, by addressing the shortage of organ donors, and efforts to create an ecosystem to facilitate organ donation in India.

## ORGAN INDIA

Organ Receiving & Giving Awareness Network (ORGAN) India is an initiative of the Parashar Foundation, and fully supported by the Vijaya Gujral Foundation, two non-profit organizations based in Delhi. Its main objective is to promote widespread awareness on organ donation. ORGAN India works under the aegis of the National Organ & Tissue Transplant Organisation (NOTTO).

#### Our Story

The Organ Receiving & Giving Awareness Network (ORGAN) India, was founded by Anika Parashar and Sunayana Singh in March 2013 after the Chairperson of the Parashar Foundation, Mrs. Kirti Parashar, was told in 2012 that she needed a heart transplant. Mrs. Parashar eventually moved to Chennai, Tamil Nadu, to wait for a new heart, which she thankfully received from an organ donor on December 13, 2013 after a four month wait.

The family underwent a lot of struggle and realised that there was an urgent need to raise awareness and disseminate information about organ donation in India. The personal hardships faced by the family motivated them to help other people, and thus ORGAN India was born.

### Vijaya Gujral Foundation

The Vijaya Gujral Foundation is a Public Charitable Trust which was founded in April, 1988, by Late Dr. (Smt.) Vimla V. Gujral, in the memory of her husband Shri Vijaya Kumar Gujral. Since its inception, the foundation has helped people with medical bills, education, preventive health care, balwadis, mobile creches, income generating programmes for women, health, hygiene & development work amongst a myriad of other projects.

Organ donation also became a personal cause for the family, as Mrs. Megha Gujral Jalota, Mrs. Parashar's sister passed away due to a liver failure following a second heart & first kidney transplant in 2014. Vijaya Gujral Foundation has joined the cause of organ donation, fully supporting ORGAN India in its mission.

# **COLLABORATIVE CONCLAVE**

SECOND COLLABORATIVE CONCLAVE for Organ Donation

The Second Collaborative Conclave for Organ Donation was held in New Delhi on November 28th, 2017 at the NOTTO office, Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi. More than 20 Non Governmental Organisations (NGOs) working in the field of Organ Donation participated in the Conclave.

At ORGAN India, we firmly believe that a combined force of all NGOs across India, working together to spread awareness on organ donation is the best way to move forward. To further the association of various stakeholders, the First Collaborative Conclave for Organ Donation was organised by ORGAN India in New Delhi on December 1, 2016.

#### Collaborative Conclave for Organ Donation

Aims & Objectives



 Network building: The Collaborative Conclave 2016 facilitated contact between organisations from different parts of the country. NGOs working in one state helped organising awareness sessions in different states

- Collaboration between NOTTO and NGOs: An open platform for communication between NOTTO and different NGOs has helped in better coordination and increased efficiency of efforts for promotion of organ donation in the country.
- Online portal launched: The NGO Portal http://collaborativeconclave.com has been set up, where all NGOs can share information.
- School curriculum: Different NGOs approached the State Governments for conducting awareness sessions in schools, like ORGAN India, who is conducting awareness sessions in all schools of Delhi.



# **CONCLAVE GOALS & ACTION POINTS**

#### **Common Donor Card across India**

After intense discussions, it was decided to have one common design for Donor Cards of all Government and Private Institutions working for Deceased Organ Donation. Within 3 months, NGOs need to start issuing the same Government issued Donor Cards in order to streamline the process. NGOs can have their organisation logo at the back of the card.

#### Building Awareness among School Children

All NGOs would follow the example of NGOs - Shine India Foundation (Kota, Rajasthan) and ORGAN India (Delhi) who have successfully received the support of the Directorate of Education in their respective cities to conduct awareness sessions in schools. It was further decided to lobby for a Chapter on Organ Donation in school books across the country.

#### Funding For NGOs

As NGOs are doing the bulk of the work across the country in organ donation, and are indispensable to the cause, they need financial support from the government. It has been decided that all NGOs would write collectively to the Indian Government to consider providing financial support to NGOs.

#### Need for a National Swap Transplant Registry

A need for a National Swap Transplant Registry was recognized as an alternative for people waiting for an organ transplant. NGOs get a lot of calls from people asking to be connected to a Swap Registry.

#### Need for Better Collateral For Dissemination & Employment of New Age Communication Tools

Quality of Collaterals available in India vis-a-vis what is being produced abroad is poor. Joint projects to produce quality material by pooling resources were discussed. Employment of new age communication tools, social media and other current channels to promote the message of Organ Donation effectively amongst diverse audience were discussed.



### What is the Body Donation Directory?

ORGAN India launched the Pan-India Body Donation Directory, which is a unique online database of Medical Colleges, NGOs all over India, duly authorised by the State Government to accept voluntary donations of whole body after death.

The Directory is available in a drop-down menu on our website www.organindia.org, and provides specific information about each Medical Institution or NGO that accepts bodies in every city and state - including names, phone numbers and email ids of the contact persons across India. The information can be accessed by anyone, anywhere over the country.

The Directory has been a result of the consistent time and efforts of the ORGAN India team over a period of 9 months to collect the data and compile it for public use.




### **CELEBRITY ENDORSEMENTS**

#### EACH ONE REACH ONE




